In Jeffrey Gitomer's book, The Little Book of Leadership, he writes, "Every one of those 'legacy' people,' and thousands more just like them, worked hard until the last minute of their last day. Be one of those people."

This really resonates with me. I am not done. I still have a lot to offer the world. Choice Theory isn't everywhere yet!

My brother died January 10 at the age of 90. (He was much older than me!) His nurses, attendants, and staff cried when they heard the news. Even his dental hygienist was sobbing when she was told of his passing. She said that whenever her hands weren't in his mouth, he was singing. He was always singing. He brought joy to everyone he came in contact with. His treatment of others left a legacy.



The legacy people that Gitomer wrote about had an impact well beyond their lives because of the teams they built and how they cared about those around them. That fits very well with Dr. Glasser's Caring Habits. That is the crossroads at which I see GIFCT right now. What is the legacy that we are leaving. Can I contribute one more resource to someone today? How can I help?

Last month, Carleen Glasser contributed over 2000 books from the Glasser warehouse to GIFCT. I drove a Suburban to California and brought them home. Carleen's wish is that we, as a nonprofit organization, would give those books away. I am excited about this opportunity to give.
